


Most popular hobbies of UK children aged 4-18

Children spend an average of **3 hours** a week taking part in their main hobby.




Swimming and shooting are the least time-consuming hobbies, with children spending an average of just 2 hours a week taking part in these activities.


Most expensive vs least expensive hobbies








On average, UK parents spend **£41 a month** on their child's main hobbγ. This equates to almost **£500 (£493)** per γear for each child.







ARE PARENTS UNDER PRESSURE TO SPEND MONEY ON THEIR CHILDREN'S HOBBIES?



More than 1 in 3 (38%) parents feel under pressure to buy their child the latest gear/kit for their hobby.



Young parents feel more under pressure for their



20% of parents aged 25-34 feel pressured



2% of parents aged 55+ feel pressured



and 52%

of younger parents (25-34) feel under pressure to spend money on their children's hobbies

London parents feel the most pressure for their child to take part in their hobby

8% of London parents have felt pressure from other parents.
